Ages:

Children ages 3rd – 8th grade

Camp Times:

Hours will be 9 a.m.-3 p.m.

Students may be dropped off after 8:45.

Please pick up promptly at 3pm.

Drop Off and Pick Up:

A staff member will sign each participant at the beginning of the day. At the end of each day, a staff member will sign out the student to their parent. If the person picking up is not the person on this Registration Form, a signed letter must be submitted prior to pick-up. Use any of our 3 parking lots.

Lunch:

Students will have lunch at approximately 11:30 each day. Lunches are stored inside a cool building, but not refrigerated. Water, sports drink or juice are recommended.

Sun and Swimming:

Please provide sunscreen and a towel. Supervised campers will be wading or swimming in shallow water only - if concerned, provide your child with a *life jacket*. (No swimming during foul weather.)

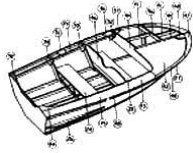

Boat Building Camp



Join the Watermen's Museum and learn the basics of boat construction. Campers will compare and contrast boat types, learn to loft (draw) boat plans, do some rowing, and use hand tools to help build a traditional Chesapeake Bay rowing skiff. Get your hands dirty and join us for a hands-on week of fun learning.



Archeology Camp

What mysteries lie beneath the shores and waters of the York River? Explore the basics of land & underwater archeology. Activities include learning about tools and procedures, establishing a dig site, artifact identification, curation and site preservation.

Nature Explorer

Explorers will study and analyze diverse habitats of woodlands, wetlands, dunes and shallow waters on and near Museum property. Learn to become good stewards by helping to preserve our shared Chesapeake Bay resources.

Fun and Games

Education is not all work and no play. There will be plenty of fun and games planned to go along with the program activities throughout the week.

Crafts

The kids will also work on craft projects associated with the program theme.

Beach Patrol
